"Towards a Greener Davos" Concept

Davos-Klosters, Switzerland 23-27 January 2013

General Information

At the World Economic Forum Annual Meeting 2013, the Forum will pursue an initiative that it introduced three years ago to address participants' concerns about the environmental impact of the Meeting.

The "Towards a Greener Davos" initiative aims to lower the amount of pollutants released into the environment by the over 2,500 participants and staff travelling to and within Davos and Klosters. This initiative further advances the Forum's mission of "improving the state of the world".

This year again, a complimentary shuttle bus service will operate exclusively for Annual Meeting participants from Zurich-Kloten Airport to Davos and Klosters, and back to the airport. The shuttle service will run every hour on the hour on Tuesday 22 January from 07.00 to 22.00 and Wednesday 23 January from 07.00 to 20.00. On Sunday 27 January, shuttles will operate for the return from Davos from 05.00 to 12.00 every hour on the hour, and from Klosters from 05.15 to 12.15 every hour at 15 minutes past the hour.

In addition to this free service, shuttle buses will run frequently within Davos at 10-minute intervals, allowing drop-off service at the Congress Centre and hotels, including the secured hotels (Hotel Belvédère, Kongress Hotel, Hotel Hilton Garden Inn and Hotel Seehof). Buses from Klosters to Davos and back will be provided for participants staying in Klosters.

Greener Davos Car Sticker

A significant way to lower emissions is not only to reduce overall traffic, but also to restrict circulation to environmentally friendly vehicles. To support the "Towards a Greener Davos" concept and to receive a Greener Davos sticker, the following requirements must be respected from Tuesday 22 January to Sunday 27 January, inclusive.

Limousine

CO ₂ emission rate	Maximum 191g/km
Fuel consumption	Maximum 9l/100 km
Energy tag	Category D or lower

Van (vehicles with 6-9 seats, including driver)

CO₂ emission rate Maximum 235g/km

To verify whether your vehicle meets the environmentally friendly requirements, please check the following website:

These requirements do not apply to vehicles with a capacity of more than nine seats, including the driver.

<u>Important:</u> The delivery of the Greener Davos car sticker is based on a vehicle model/car paper inspection in Davos and will be delivered **only** if the participant(s) is present in the vehicle. However, as of Tuesday 22 January from 08.00 this is no longer required. A leaflet about the initiative will be distributed by our team directly to the participant(s). Unlike last year, vehicles and drivers **do not need to be registered in advance**. The entire procedure will take place at the Greener Davos car sticker issuing point.

The Greener Davos car sticker will be issued at the following location: Dorfstrasse 20-22 (150 metres after the tunnel entering Davos, when arriving from Zurich, on the right side of the street). Stickers will be issued from 21 to 23 January (07.30 - 03.00) and from 24 to 26 January (07.30 - 20.00).

To support the "Towards a Greener Davos" concept and to provide you with the best service, cars with a Greener Davos car sticker may access the following special waiting zones: Kirchner Museum (opposite the Hotel Belvédère), Hotel Schweizerhof and Registration (Kurgartenstrasse). They will also be able to access the hotels in the secured zones for participants' check-in and check-out.

As the waiting zones are not car parking areas, the driver has to stay in the car and the motor has to be turned off. Horlauben is not a waiting zone, but a drop-off/pick-up zone.
