Towards a Greener Davos

Frequently Asked Questions

- **How can I get around Davos as part of the “Towards a Greener Davos” initiative?**
While in Davos, participants can take public transportation, use the complementary Forum shuttle buses or walk. You can also go by car, but will need a Greener Davos car sticker to access special zones.
- **When does the Greener Davos initiative start?**
The initiative starts on Tuesday 22 January at 07.00 and ends on Sunday 27 January at 08.00.
- **Is there transportation from Zurich to Davos for Annual Meeting participants before the Annual Meeting?**
A complimentary shuttle bus service from Zurich to Davos will run every hour on the hour on Tuesday 22 January from 07.00 to 22.00 and Wednesday 23 January from 07.00 to 20.00. You can also come from the Zurich airport (www.sbb.ch) by train; the trip takes 2 hours and 45 minutes. There is also public transportation within Davos with frequent service (www.vbd.ch).
- **How can I go from Zurich airport to my hotel in Davos-Klosters?**
A complimentary shuttle bus service is available to transport all participants to Davos and Klosters as per the schedule above. To use the shuttle service, please go to the transport desk of Terminal 1 at the Zurich Airport. The Forum shuttle bus service, which is free of charge, will drop you off at your hotel.
- **What is the frequency of the bus service from Zurich to Davos and Davos to Zurich?**
Every hour on the hour (see schedule above)
- **What is the frequency of the shuttle service within Davos?**
Every 10 minutes.
- **Is there still shuttle service on Sunday after the Annual Meeting within Davos and back to Zurich?**
Yes, complimentary shuttle buses leave from the shuttle hub on Sunday 27 January from 05.00 to 12.00 every hour on the hour, and from Klosters from 05.15 to 12.15 every hour at 15 minutes past the hour. Participants must register in advance at the Additional Activities Desk located in the Hospitality Area in the Congress Centre in Davos
- **Will non-badge holders be allowed to use the shuttle service?**
No
- **How can I get from Klosters to Davos?**
By train (depending on the schedule), by complimentary Forum shuttle bus or by car

- **What area does the Greener Davos initiative cover?**
Please see the attached map.
- **Do vehicles and drivers need to be registered in advance to receive a Greener Davos car sticker?**
No.
- **Where do I get a Greener Davos car sticker?**
The Greener Davos car sticker will be issued at the following location: Dorfstrasse 20-22 (150 metres after the tunnel entering Davos, when arriving from Zurich, on the right side of the street). Stickers will be issued from 21 to 23 January (07.30 - 03.00) and from 24 to 26 January (07.30 - 20.00).
- **How do I verify if the car corresponds to the Greener Davos norms?**
Forum staff will base their information on the standards and norms of the Federal Traffic Authorities of Switzerland: <http://www.bfe.admin.ch/energieetikette/00886/04331/index.html?lang=de>
- **Do participants need to be in the car while picking up the Greener Davos car sticker?**
Yes. However, as of Tuesday 22 January from 08.00 this is no longer required.
- **Can I access Davos without a Greener Davos car sticker?**
Yes, except the security perimeter around the Kongress Hotel, the Hotel Hilton Garden Inn, the Congress Centre, the Hotel Belvédère and the Hotel Seehof.
- **Will delivery trucks have any problems getting to their specified drop-off locations?**
Delivery vehicles are not affected by this initiative, but drivers have to apply for a security car sticker to access the Congress Centre security zone.
- **Which vehicles are affected by the Greener Davos concept?**
All vehicles except delivery vehicles and vehicles with more than nine (including driver) seats are concerned.
- **Does the Greener Davos concept apply to vehicles of official delegations?**
Yes, except those with official diplomatic plates, or cars accompanied by the police for security reasons (motorcades, armoured cars).
- **Can I access the Congress Centre with the Greener Davos car sticker?**
No.
- **What is the difference between an AA-security car sticker and a Greener Davos car sticker?**
The Greener Davos car sticker certifies that cars fulfil the Greener Davos requirements, which have been established by the World Economic Forum according the Federal Authorities of Switzerland. AA-security car stickers grant access to the Congress Centre security zone.

- I am travelling with my own car and I am staying at a hotel located in the secured zone (Belvédère/Seehof/Kongress/Hilton Garden Inn). I want to check in and drop off my suitcases at the hotel before going to the Registration Area to pick up my badge. Can I access my hotel without a car sticker?

No. You need to pick up a Greener Davos car sticker at the issuing point.
