Visa

Deadline

The deadline set by the Tianjin Municipal Government to issue the visa invitation letter is 21 June 2016. After this date, we will not be able to support your request.

Application process

Please make sure that your passport (and, if relevant, that of your spouse) is valid for at least six months after the meeting, i.e. early January 2017 onwards. If not, you must renew your passport as soon as possible.

If you indicated on the registration form that you need a visa, please note the following:

Wait for your visa invitation letter from the Tianjin Municipal Government

The Tianjin Municipal Government will send you a visa invitation letter by email. Please note that processing your visa invitation letter will normally take five working days.

Go to the nearest embassy or consulate and apply for a visa

Once you have received the visa invitation letter, take it with the other documents required by the Chinese authorities to your nearest Chinese embassy, consulate or visa office, where you will be provided with a visa application form. Alternatively, you can download it ahead of time from the Chinese embassy, consulate or visa office's website. Visa officers at Chinese embassies or consulates make the final decision on the validity, duration of stay and time of entry of a visa and may require applicants to provide additional relevant documents. For general inquiries on visa issues, please consult your nearest Chinese embassy, consulate or visa office.

As a reminder, please ensure that your visa-related information entered in your registration form is accurate. If your visa-related information has changed, please write to AMNCVisa@weforum.org. Note that it takes 21 days for the Tianjin Municipal Government to reissue a corrected visa invitation letter.

Air travel

Participants should make their own flight arrangements.

Tianjin Binhai International Airport

Tianjin can be reached by frequent and short flight connections from most major airports in Asia, including Shanghai, Hong Kong SAR, Seoul and Nagoya. The airport is 30 kilometres from downtown Tianjin and the transfer time to the official hotels is about 50 minutes, depending on traffic. A complimentary shuttle service will be available from the airport to the official hotels on arrival, and from the official hotels to both airports on departure. (see Airport transfer below)

Beijing Capital International Airport

Tianjin is 150 kilometres from Beijing Capital International Airport and the transfer time to Tianjin is about two and a half hours, depending on traffic. A complimentary shuttle service will be available from the airport to the official hotels on arrival, and from the official hotels to both airports on departure. (see Airport transfer below)

Private jet

For private jets, the aviation company needs to apply for approval from the Civil Aviation Administration of China 15 days before the arrival date. Please contact tjprivatejets2016@163.com (+86 13516196963) to submit your request.



Train from/to Beijing

The Beijing-Tianjin Intercity Railway is a high-speed rail line between Beijing and Tianjin. The 117-kilometre line was built to accommodate trains with a maximum speed of 350kmh (217 mph) and high-speed trains on the line reach a top speed of 330 kmh (205mph). When the line opened on 1 August 2008, it had the fastest conventional train service in the world and reduced travel time between the two cities from 70 to 30 minutes.

Approximately four trains leave every hour from Beijing South to Tianjin and Tianjin to Beijing South. A one-way fare costs between RMB 60-100 (€8-€13.5; \$9-



Practical Information

About Tianjin

Tianjin is a coastal city in northern China and the country's third-largest urban area after Shanghai and Beijing. Tianjin is 100 kilometres from Beijing and can be reached by high-speed train in 35 minutes. Frequent and short flights connect it to most major airports in Asia.

Tianjin's pillar industries include aviation and aerospace, petrochemicals, equipment manufacturing, electronic information, bio-pharmaceuticals, and alternative energy and materials. It has a large concentration of high-tech industries.

Dress code

A business suit or smart casual wear is appropriate throughout the meeting and for the Cultural Soirée. No formal attire is required.

Time zone

Tianjin is eight hours ahead of GMT/UTC.

Lithium batteries

According to the Specifications for Air Transport of Dangerous Goods Carried by Passengers or Crew, the rated energy of lithium batteries that are taken onto an airplane either in hand luggage or consigned luggage should not exceed 160wh. Air passengers carrying electronic applications with lithium batteries and spare batteries should pay attention to the following:

- Electronic products that contain lithium batteries, such as watches, calculators, cameras, mobile phones, portable computers and DVs, can be taken as hand luggage and consigned in the checked luggage. The rated energy of the batteries should not exceed 100wh; for those between 100wh and 160wh, the passenger must get the permission of the air company. The electric appliances should be carefully kept to prevent any unexpected start-up.
- Spare batteries can only be carried as hand luggage and should be well preserved to avoid a short-circuit. The rated energy of each battery should not exceed 100wh. For batteries between 100wh and 160wh, the passenger must get the permission of the air company; each passenger is allowed to take up to two spare batteries.
