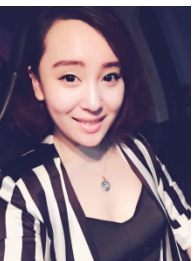


Jonathan Barcant, Co-Founder, IAMovement, Port of Spain Hub
